General:

Application No. 97 was filed May 12, 1906 by W. S. Adams for 25.0 c.f.s. of water from a spring located in unsurveyed lands for mining and milling purposes. The proposed place of use is described as "situated about 3 miles east of the place called Middlegate and about 6 miles west of Eastgate, Churchill County, Nevada.

A letter was sent from this office, by certified mail, to the best available address for the applicant, on July 26, 1968. This letter requested additional information before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped "unknown" "insufficient address". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 97 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and that the approval of this application, without the requested information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
