R U L I N G

General:

Application No. 3925 was filed by Leo Lucey on April 24, 1916 to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from Copenhagen Creek for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 36, T. 15N., R. 49E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use was described as being 50 acres of unsurveyed land.

A letter dated July 24, 1968 was sent by certified mail to the best available address for the applicant requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned, stamped "unclaimed", by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 3925 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and the approval of this application, without said information, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
