

Application 5635 was filed July 24, 1919, by Joseph Giraud for 200 acre-feet of water for stock watering purposes. The proposed source is the run-off from melting snow on the NW slope of Mount Hicks. The place of use and storage is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T.5N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M."

A letter was sent to the applicant by this office under certified mail on August 8, 1968, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped: "Addressee Unknown." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of a current mailing address.

RULING

Application 5635 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
