RULING

GENERAL:

Application 6326 was filed on November 17, 1920, by Harry K. Brown and G. L. Chism to change the place of use of 3.0 cfs of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The source is Ash Creek Springs and Tributaries and the point of diversion is described as being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 12, T6S., R60E., MDB&M. The proposed place of use is described as being 115 acres located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 18, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 19, all in T6S., R61E., MDB&M. The existing place of use is 115 acres described as being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 18, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 19, all in T6S., R61E., MDB&M.

A letter was sent by this office by certified mail to the applicants on August 12, 1968, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped "Moved, left no address". It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 6326 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successor in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application, without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
