R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Applications 7190 and 7191 were filed on August 8, 1924 for permission to appropriate 3.0 c.f.s. of water each from Gold Run Range (underground) for mining purposes.

The proposed point of diversion and place of use under these applications is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T. 34 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter, dated September 12, 1968 was sent by certified mail to the applicant at the best available address, requesting additional information necessary before permits could be issued under these applications. This letter was returned stamped "addressee unknown--insufficient address" by the post office department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Applications 7190 and 7191 are herewith denied on the grounds that the granting of permits under these applications without the requested information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
