GENERAL:

Application No. 23161 was filed by Green Valley Acres on June 1, 1966 for permission to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for Quasi Municipal and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 27, T. 19 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 27, T. 19 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. This application proposes to serve 50 motel units, 50 trailer spaces and one service station.

A letter dated September 13, 1968 was sent by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before permit could be issued under this application. The return receipt card signed by Pauline Shlesky was received in this office September 19, 1968.

A letter dated September 13, 1968 was sent to the Public Service Commission inquiring if this applicant had filed for a certificate of public conveyance and necessity. Their reply dated October 4, 1968 states that no application has been made by Green Valley Acres in the area described.

RULING

Application 23161 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the requested information and failed to secure a certificate of public conveyance and necessity and the granting of a permit under this application without said information and certificate would be detrimental to the public welfare.
