R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 21695 was filed on December 18, 1963, by John Paul Cayton to appropriate 0.05 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal purposes, (hotel, bar, motel). The proposed point of diversion is within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 26, T.24S., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., Ivanpah Valley, Northern Part. The proposed place of use is within a portion of the same subdivision as the point of diversion. Application 21695 was filed in behalf of John Paul Cayton by Tyson Engineering Co., acting as agent.

First notice for permit fees was mailed to Tyson Engineering Co. on June 18, 1968. The second notice was mailed to Tyson Engineering Co. on July 18, 1968. Third and final notice was mailed on August 23, 1968, via certified mail to John Paul Cayton, the applicant, with a copy mailed via certified mail to Tyson Engineering Co. The notice mailed to the applicant was returned to this office with the notation: "Insufficient Address" stamped on the envelope. A return receipt card was received in this office on August 27, 1968, signed by C. Long for Tyson Engineering Co. dated August 23, 1968, establishing receipt of the certified copy. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of a current and complete mailing address. No permit fees have been received in answer to these notices.

RULING

Application No. 21695 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant, or his agent, failed to submit the statutory permit fees as provided by NRS 533.435 after proper notice dated August 23, 1968.
