RULING

GENERAL:

Application 7114 was filed by Blanche Siard on May 12, 1924, for permission to change the place of use of 0.27 cfs of water heretofore appropriated under Certificate 500, subject of permit 3682, from Coyote Springs for irrigation purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 30, T30N., R39E., MDB&M. The proposed place of use is described as 27.21 acres within portions of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 32, T30N., R39E., MDB&M.

A letter dated September 12, 1968, was sent to the applicant by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. A return receipt was received in this office on September 16, 1968, signed by Ed Hager. The above mentioned letter gave the applicant 30 days in which to submit the requested information. No correspondence has been received in reply to this letter.

RULING:

Application 7114 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the requested information and the granting of a permit under this application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
