RULING

GENERAL:

Application 7197 was filed by Western Pacific Railroad Company on August 21, 1924, for permission to appropriate 1.03 cfs of water from an underground source for domestic, culinary, round house and boiler use. The proposed point of diversion and place of use are described as being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 22, T34N., R55E., MDB&M.

A letter dated September 12, 1968, was sent to the applicants by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. A 30 day period of time was given for the submission of said information. A return receipt was received in this office on September 16, 1968, signed by Charles B. Evans, Jr. No correspondence has been received from the applicant in reply to the above mentioned letter.

RULING:

Application 7197 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the requested information and that the granting of a permit without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
