GENERAL:


Application 17943 was filed on April 20, 1959 for 1.0 cfs of water for mining & milling purposes. The proposed source is Princess Spring and is to be diverted in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 31, T. 1 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 30, W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 31, T. 1 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M., and E $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 36, SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 25, T. 1 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on November 7, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. A return receipt card signed by Julia J. Hughes for Fred Harvey was received in this office December 23, 1968.
