R U L I N G

GENERAL

Application 7168 was filed by Lovelock Lands, Inc. on July 13, 1924, to appropriate 100 c.f.s. of water from the Humboldt River for irrigation (13,920 acres) and stock-watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1, T. 25 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the 300 acres in Section 2, T. 25 N., R. 31 E., 500 acres in Section 10; 160 acres in Section 11; 500 acres in Section 16; 300 acres in Section 21; all Sections 7, 8, 9, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 30, T. 25 N., R. 31 E.; all Sections 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27, T. 25 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B.&M.


A portion of Application 7168 now stands in the name of Lovelock Lands, Inc. and a portion in the name of Harry W. Sommers, et als, as the owners of record by proper assignment filed in this office.

A letter was sent to each of the owners of record on January 23, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 7168. The letter sent to Lovelock Lands, Inc. was returned by the Post Office Department stamped: "Unclaimed" and the letter to Harry W. Sommers, et als, was marked: "Deceased." It is the responsibility of the owners of record or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 7168 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owners of record or their successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
