R U L I N G

GENERAL

Application 5120 was filed by P. J. Conway on June 22, 1918, to appropriate 2.45 c.f.s. of water from the Main Walker River for irrigation (245 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within 75 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, 100 acres E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 16, 30 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, 40 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on March 17, 1969, requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 5120. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "Addressee Unknown" and "Moved not forwardable." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

RULING

Application 5120 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
