GENERAL:

106 Application 14040 was filed by Freeman E. Fairfield on February 5, 1952, to change the point of diversion and place of use of 0.11 c.f.s. of water heretofore appropriated as set forth in the Walker River Decree, Equity C-125, Page 60 (James T. McKay). The existing point of diversion is from the West Walker River in the State of California and the description is not given in the Decree. The existing place of use is described as 40 acres within portions of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T. 6 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T.10N.,R.23E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is 12 acres in portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T.10N.,R.25E.,M.D.B.&M. Protests to the granting of Application No. 14040 were filed on May 19, 1952, by the Walker River Irrigation District and by Norman D. Brown.

Application 14041 was filed by Freeman E. Fairfield on February 5, 1952, to change the point of diversion and place of use of 0.06 c.f.s. of water heretofore appropriated as set forth in the Walker River Decree, Equity C-125, Page 60 (James T. McKay). The existing point of diversion is from the West Walker River in the State of California and the description is not given in the Decree. The existing place of use is described as 40 acres within portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.6N.,R.23E.,M.D.B.&M. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T.10N.,R.23E.,M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is 7 acres in portions of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16 and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T.10N.,R.23E., M.D.B.&M. Protests to the granting of Application 14041 were filed on May 19, 1952, by the Walker River Irrigation District and by Norman D. Brown.

Application 14042 was filed by Freeman E. Fairfield on February 5, 1952, to change the point of diversion and place of use of 0.18 c.f.s. of water heretofore appropriated as set forth in the Walker River Decree, Equity C-125, Page 60 (James T. McKay) the existing point of diversion is from the West Walker River in the State of California and the description is not given in the Decree. The existing place of use is described as 40 acres within portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.6N.,R.23E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T.10N.,R.23E.,M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is 22 acres in a portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T.10N.,R.23E.,M.D.B.&M. Protests of the granting of Application 14042 were filed on May 19, 1952, by the Walker River Irrigation District and by Norman D. Brown.

Application 14043 was filed by Freeman E. Fairfield on February 5, 1952, to change the point of diversion and place of use of 0.07 c.f.s. of water heretofore appropriated as set forth in the Walker River Decree, Equity C-125, Page 60 (James T. McKay). The existing point of diversion is from the West Walker River in the State of California and the description is not given in the Decree. The existing place of use is described as 40 acres within portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.6N.,R.23E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T.10N.,R.23E.,M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is 9 acres in a portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T.10N.,R.23E.,M.D.B.&M. Protests to the granting of Application 14043 were filed on May 19, 1952, by the Walker River Irrigation District and by Norman D. Brown.

Application 14044 was filed by Freeman E. Fairfield on February 5, 1952, to change the point of diversion and place of use of 0.22 c.f.s. of water heretofore appropriated as set forth in the Walker River Decree, Equity C-125, Page 60 (James T. McKay). The existing point of diversion is from the West Walker River in the State of California and the description is not given in the Decree. The existing place of use is described as 40 acres within portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.6N.,R.23E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.10N.,R.23E.,M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as 25 acres in portions of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T.10N.,R.23E.,M.D.B.&M. Protests to


) the granting of Application 14044 were filed on May 19, 1952, by the Walker River Irrigation District and by Norman D. Brown.
