RULING


GENERAL:

Application 5233 was filed by Patrick Donovan on August 26, 1918, to appropriate 1.5 cfs of water from the Walker River for irrigation (160 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T13N., R25E., MDB&M. The place of use is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T13N., R25E., MDB&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on March 18, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 5233. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "No such Post Office in State - name unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

Application 5233 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested; and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
