GENERAL

Application 9390 was filed by H. M. Payne on December 12, 1930, to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Payne Spring for stockwatering (4,000 sheep and 800 cattle) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, T.9N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 8, T.9N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M.

Protests to the granting of this application were filed by Ira Fallon on October 30, 1931, and informally by Paul M. Yparraguirre on November 14, 1931.

Application 9390 now stands in the name of P. G. Morgan, as the owner of record by proper assignment filed in this office.

A letter was sent to the owner of record on March 24, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 9390. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "Addressee unknown." It is the responsibility of the owner of record or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

Application 9390 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owner of record or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
