GENERAL

109 Application No. 8502 was filed by P. G. Morgan on April 13, 1928 to appropriate 0.25 cfs of water from Box Spring for stock-watering (800 cattle, 4,000 sheep) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, T. 9 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, T. 9 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M.


Protest to the granting of this application was filed by Paul M. Yparraguirre on March 13, 1929. Application 8502 now stands in the name of Lloyd T. Springmeyer, as the owner of record by proper assignment filed in this office.

A letter was sent to the owner of record on March 24, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application No. 8502. The certified mail return receipt card was returned to this office on April 7, 1969.

RULING

Application No. 8502 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owner of record or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
