R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 24486 was filed on May 13, 1968, by Dora May Keller to appropriate 3.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for irrigation purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within Lot 2 Section 7, T.17N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 6, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Lot 2, Sec. 7, T.17N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M. Application 24486 has been assigned to Leonard Peter Christiansen.

Application 24486 was protested on September 19, 1968, by Kennecott Copper Corp. on the grounds that it would impair and conflict with the value of existing rights; that it would be against public policy to grant said application; and that it would be contrary to statute.


There are no wells with valid permits where the point of diversion is located within one-half mile of the proposed point of diversion under Application 24486.

It is the finding of the State Engineer that the granting of a permit under Application 24486 will not conflict with or impair the value of existing rights, or be detrimental to the public interest, or be contrary to statute.

RULING:

The protest of Application 24486 is hereby overruled, and a permit will be issued on receipt of the statutory permit fees. The permit will be issued subject to the limitation that the total duty of water for the lands irrigated shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.
