GENERAL:

25 Application 9195 was filed on January 4, 1930, for 0.25 c.f.s. of water for stockwatering purposes. The proposed source is Harry Spring and is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29, T.38N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on July 11, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped: "Deceased." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

RULING

Application 9195 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
