R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 3707 was filed on November 19, 1915 for 1.0 c.f.s. of water for irrigation, stockwatering and domestic purposes. The proposed source is Job's Canyon Spring and is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 12 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M. The 100 acres described under the place of use are within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T. 12 N., R. 19 E.

A letter was sent to the applicant on August 7, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The applicant was given 30 days in which to reply. A return receipt card signed by Eugene Scossa was received in this office on August 12, 1969 and no reply was received within 30 days of that date.

RULING

Application 3707 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
