

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION 8177 FILED BY)
GRASS VALLEY LAND AND LIVESTOCK COMPANY FOR)
PERMISSION TO APPROPRIATE WATER FROM INDIAN)
CREEK SPRING IN LANDER COUNTY, NEVADA.)

GENERAL:

58 Application 8177 was filed by Grass Valley Land and Live-
stock Company on June 17, 1927, for permission to appropriate
0.005 c.f.s. of water from Indian Creek Spring for watering of
2,500 head of sheep. The proposed point of diversion and place
of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, T. 27 N.,
R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M.

This application was protested by the Ellison Ranching Co.,
on October 21, 1927, on the grounds that this spring is tributary
to Fish Creek which the protestants have use for irrigation and
stock watering and claimed vested right thereto.

A letter was sent by certified mail to applicant on Septem-
ber 15, 1969, requesting additional information necessary before
a permit could be issued under this application. This letter
was returned to this office stamped "Unclaimed-Unknown", by the
Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant
or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of
their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 8177 is herewith denied on the grounds that
the applicant failed to submit the requested information and
the granting of a permit under this application without said
information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
