RULING

GENERAL:

Application 8193 was filed by Frank Ludwig on June 22, 1927, for permission to appropriate 1.0 c.f.s. of water from Archie Spring for irrigation (160 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, T. 18 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T. 18 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest was filed by Adams-McGill Company on May 20, 1928, under this application on the grounds that said company has a vested right to the waters of this spring.

A letter was sent by certified mail to the applicant on September 15, 1969, requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned stamped "Unclaimed", by the Post Office Department.

RULING

Application 8193 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and the granting of a permit under this application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
