R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application No. 13712 was filed by the City of Hawthorne on May 10, 1951, to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Summit Springs for domestic (municipal water supply) purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 27, T. 8 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B.&M.

Application No. 13713 was filed on May 10, 1951 by the City of Hawthorne to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Little Squaw Spring for domestic (municipal water supply) purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24, T. 7 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M. and the proposed place of use is within Section 27, T. 8 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B.&M.

There are no other rights of record in this office to appropriate water from the above described sources.

Each of the above applications was protested on July 18, 1951 by Lucky Boy Consolidated Mines Co. on the grounds that "that the protestant company-- Lucky Boy Consolidated Mines Co. is the owner of a vested right to use the water of said Spring and that said right has never been abandoned, and that there are insufficient waters from said spring to satisfy protestant's rights and those claimed by applicant".

A field investigation was held on July 31, 1952, at which representatives of the applicant and the protestant were present.

Subsequent to the field investigation, a formal hearing was held at the Mineral County Court House in Hawthorne, Nevada on Tuesday, April 7, 1953.

RULING

The protests to Applications 13712 and 13713 are herewith overruled and permits will be issued under each of the applications, subject to existing rights, upon payment of the statutory permit fees.




