R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 8760 was filed on November 10, 1928 for 0.05 c.f.s. of water for stockwatering purposes. The proposed source is Ruth Spring and is to be diverted in the NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 15, T. 14 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on October 24, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The applicant was given 30 days in which to reply. The certified return receipt card was not received in this office. On 11/28/69 a tracer was initiated to the post office department to see if the letter was received. A reply from the post office department was received 12/2/69 indicating that the letter was delivered on 10/27/69 and the employee of the firm accepting the letter was L. Carson.

RULING

Application 8760 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successor in interest failed to submit the information requested and approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
