R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 17356 was filed by Fred S. Allman and Arnold Dummar on August 14, 1957 to appropriate 16.0 c.f.s. of water from (Truckee River) Fernley-Hazen Drainage Canal.

The point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T. 20 N., R. 27 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17; Section 16, T. 20 N., R. 27 E., M.D.B.&M. where the water is to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes.

Protest to the granting of this application was filed by A. W. Champagne on August 14, 1957.

A letter was sent to the owner of record on November 6, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 17356. No reply has been received to this inquiry.

RULING

Application 17356 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owner of record has failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
