R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 5692 was filed by H. Leter on August 17, 1919 to appropriate 20 c.f.s. of water from the Carson River. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, T. 20 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within portions of Section 18, T. 21 N., R. 30 E., Sections 2 and 10, T. 20 N., R. 29 E., and Section 24, T. 21 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M.

Protest to the granting of this application was filed by Newlands Project, U.S.R.S. on September 24, 1919.

A letter was sent to the applicant on November 24, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 5692. No reply or expression of interest has been received to this inquiry.

RULING

Application 5692 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
