GENERAL:

100 Application 9308 was filed by J. B. Sorhouet on July 26, 1930, for permission to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from 6-Mile Canyon Spring, and Creek, and tributaries for stock watering and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 9 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M. This application was protested by Elizabeth Wittenberg on September 5, 1931, and informally protested by Naquinta Cattle Company, September 17, 1931, which protest was withdrawn November 6, 1931. This application was transferred down to Cal Worthington on February 23, 1965. A letter was forwarded to Mr. Cal Worthington by certified mail on July 3, 1969, requesting additional information necessary before this application could be processed for a permit. A return receipt signed by Jake Wiley for Worthington Dodge was received in this office on July 9, 1969. No reply has been received to this request.

RULING

Application 9308 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owner of record failed to submit the requested information and the granting of a permit under this application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
