R U L I N G

GENERAL:


101A Application No. 4382 was filed by F. J. Howard and L. A. Friedman on April 4, 1917, for permission to appropriate 1.0 cfs of water from Howard Spring for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T. 28 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, said township and range. A protest was filed by Nevada Packard Mines Company on May 19, 1917 against this application.

A letter was sent to the owners of record on February 27, 1970, by certified mail regarding additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned by the Post Office Department, stamped "deceased". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 4382 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
