R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 8299 was filed by Burton H. Robison on August 19, 1927, for permission to appropriate 0.025 c.f.s. of water from Choke Cherry Spring No. 1 for stock watering purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 31, T.25N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest was filed under this application by William Sellas on November 21, 1927, and by James E. Duval on March 1, 1928. No further action has been taken on this application since that time.

A letter was sent by certified mail to the applicant on March 24, 1970, requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. A return receipt signed by B. H. Robison was received in this office on March 27, 1970. No reply has been received to this letter.

RULING

Application 8299 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
