GENERAL:

Application 8233 was filed by B. H. Robison on July 16, 1927, for permission to appropriate 0.025 c.f.s. of water from Choke Cherry Spring No. 3 for stock watering purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, T.24N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.


A protest was filed under this application by James Doutre on October 19, 1927. No further action has been taken since that time.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on March 24, 1970, requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. A return receipt signed by B. H. Robison was received in this office March 27, 1970. No reply to this letter has been received.
