RULING

GENERAL:

1978 Application 5575 was filed by Wm. T. O'Neil on June 24, 1919, for permission to appropriate 2.0 c.f.s. of water from Unnamed Springs (O'Neil Springs) for mining, stock and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T. 31 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest was filed by Black Forest Mining and Smelting Company on July 25, 1919.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on March 31, 1970, requesting additional information necessary before a permit can be issued under this application. This letter was returned stamped "Unknown" by the Post Office Department.

RULING

Application 5575 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit can be issued under this application.
