} RULING

Application 14609 was filed November 3, 1952 by Oscar Rudnick for the waters of Radford Spring for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 3, T. 7 S., R. 40 E. This application was protested by Oscar and Raymond Williams on December 10, 1953.

RULING

There is no record of any existing right on Radford Spring, although vested rights may exist which have never been recorded in the State Engineer's Office.

All permits issued by the State of Nevada are issued subject to valid existing rights and the rights of any prior appropriator are therefore protected. Whenever possible, multiple use of water is encouraged, and since there is no basic conflict between stockwatering use and use for mining and milling purposes, the protest of Oscar and Raymond Williams is overruled and a permit will be issued under Application 14609 upon receipt of the statutory fee.
