R U L I N G

GENERAL:

179 Application No. 9502 was filed on July 20, 1931 by Consolidated Coppermines Corporation to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of the waters of Steptoe Creek heretofore claimed under a vested right. The amount of water to be changed is 7.0 cfs to mining, milling, concentrating ores, metallurgical operations and domestic purposes.

The point of diversion is described as being in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 7, T. 15 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., and the place of use is described as being 1,814.75 acres within Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 15, 16, and 17, T. 15 N., R. 64 E., Sections 24, 25, and 36, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., Section 30 and 31, T. 16 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M.

Application No. 9502 was transferred to C-B Land and Cattle Company on June 5, 1953.

On February 26, 1970, a certified letter was forwarded to the owner of record requesting additional information. No reply or expression of interest has been received to this letter of inquiry.

RULING

Application No. 9502 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owner of record has failed to submit the requested additional information and the approval of this application, without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
