GENERAL:

16-2 Application 25784 was filed by Harold and Clarice Joslyn on September 14, 1970, for permission to appropriate 0.02 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for commercial stock watering purposes.

The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 20 S., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M.

A notice was sent on March 4, 1971 to Baughman-Haught and Turner, Inc., agents for the applicants, requesting permit fees due under this application. No reply has been received to this notice. A letter was sent to the applicants and their agents both by certified mail on April 6, 1971, giving a 30 day period in which to submit the \$10.00 fee for issuing a permit under Application 25784. A return receipt signed by C. M. Turfin for Harold Joslyn was received in this office April 8, 1971. A return receipt signed by F. Weishaupt for Baughman-Haught & Turner, Inc., was received in this office April 19, 1971. As of the date of this ruling the statutory permit fees had not been submitted.

RULING

Application 25784 is hereby denied on the grounds that the statutory permit fees as required by NRS 533.435 have not been submitted.
