GENERAL:

Application 16790 was filed by Placerville Lumber Company on November 17, 1955 for permission to appropriate 0.15 c.f.s. of water from an unnamed spring for quasi-municipal-subdivision purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 30, T. 13 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as within the E 1/2 of said Section 30.

This application was ready for action April 9, 1956. A letter was forwarded, by certified mail, to the applicants and a carbon copy was forwarded, also by certified mail, to Adams, Furrh & Reed, as agents for the applicants on August 9, 1971. Said letter requested additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. A return receipt, signed by Craig Hasse, for Adams, Furrh & Reed was received in this office August 12, 1971. A return receipt by R. L. McGonagle for Placerville Lumber Company was received in this office August 12, 1971. No reply has been received to this letter.

RULING

Application 16790 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their agent failed to submit the information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
