R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 24792 was filed by Jerry V. Peterson on December 3, 1968, for permission to appropriate 2.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal (trailer court) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 21, T. 36 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is 200 trailer spaces within portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  said Section 21.

This application was ready for action on March 17, 1969, and a request for permit fees was forwarded March 31, 1969 to the applicant. No reply was received to this notice. A letter was forwarded to the applicant by certified mail on April 30, 1969, giving a 30 day period in which to submit the statutory permit fees. A return receipt was received in this office showing receipt of this letter on May 2, 1969. No reply has been received.

Ruling

Application 24792 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the permit fees as required by NRS 533.435.
