Application 6701 was filed by Panther Mines Co. on June 17, 1922, for permission to appropriate 3.0 c.f.s. of water from Granite Creek for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T.44N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M. This application was protested by Utah Construction Company on July 28, 1922.

A letter was forwarded to the owner of record on June 26, 1969, by certified mail requesting information necessary before further action could be taken on this application. A return receipt signed by Jack Boyer for Panther Mines Company was received in this office June 30, 1969. A letter dated July 25, 1969, was received from Mr. John F. Ala expressing interest in this water right. A letter was forwarded to Mr. Ala on July 29, 1969, informing him to complete the chain of title into his name if he desired to pursue this application. No reply has been received to said letter.

A letter was sent to Mr. Ala by certified mail on April 3, 1972, requesting notification of continued interest in transferring this application into his name. A return receipt signed by Mr. Ala was received April 10, 1972. No reply has been received.

RULING

Application 6701 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the requested information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
