GENERAL:


On February 14, 1974, the Art Wilson Company filed Application 28099 for 1.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source. The proposed point of diversion is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 25, T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.& M. The proposed place of use is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 25. The water is to be used for mining, milling, and domestic purposes.

The proposed point of diversion is less than 200 feet from the point of diversion under Permit 27204 held by Julius Bunkowski to develop 2.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic purposes.

RULING:

Application 28099 is hereby denied on the grounds that its granting would tend to impair the value of an existing right.
