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GENERAL:

Application 28200 was filed on March 25, 1974, by Lowell E. and Kenna H. Boyer to appropriate 1.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.M. The place of use is described as 40 acres within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.M.

Permit 25818 in the name of Lowell E. and Kenna H. Boyer for 1.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for irrigation (40 acres) and domestic use is appurtenant to the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.M. The Proof of Beneficial Use is due on October 24, 1974.

The proposed development under Application 28200 is located in an area designated on January 22, 1973, by order of the State Engineer. Present information available indicates that the estimated perennial yield of the Dayton Valley ground water basin is 7,900 acre-feet. Existing water rights of record within the Dayton Valley underground basin exceeds the estimate of perennial yield.

RULING:

Application 28200 is hereby denied on the grounds that the granting of this application for additional withdrawal of water from this area of the Dayton Valley groundwater basin would adversely affect and tend to impair the value of existing water rights.
