R U L I N G

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GENERAL:

Applications 27611, 27612, 27613 and 28216 were filed by Cold Springs Development Corporation to appropriate underground water for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic purposes in Cold Springs Valley. Applications 27611, 27612 and 27613 were filed on July 12, 1973 and Application 28216 was filed on March 25, 1974. Applications 27611 and 28216 are for 3.0 c.f.s. each to serve 150 warehouses and 200 homes. Applications 27612 and 27613 are for 5.0 c.f.s. each to serve 2200 houses, commercial area and recreation area. The point of diversion under Application 27611 is within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.M. The point of diversion under Application 27612 is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.M. The point of diversion under Application 27613 is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.M. The point of diversion under Application 28216 is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.M. The place of use under Applications 27611 and 28216 is within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 30, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.M. The place of use under Applications 27612 and 27613 is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, N $\frac{1}{2}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.M.

The perennial yield of the ground water reservoir in Cold Springs Valley has been estimated by the U. S. Geological Survey to be 500 acre-feet of ground water per year.

Permits have been issued which could be developed to use as much as 3226 acre-feet of ground water per year.

RULING:

Applications 27611, 27612, 27613 and 28216 are hereby denied on the grounds that the granting of these applications

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would adversely affect existing water rights and be detrimental to the public welfare.
