R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Applications 29082, 29101 and 29102 were filed on December 24, 1974 by Allan E. Ross. Application 29082 is for 3.0 c.f.s. to be diverted from an underground source within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.33N., R.35E., M.D.B. & M. to be used for the irrigation of 124 acres within a portion of E $\frac{1}{2}$ said Section 21.

Application 29101 was filed for 3.0 c.f.s. of the waters of an underground source to be diverted within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.32N., R.35E., M.D.B. & M. to be used for the irrigation of 180 acres of land within portions of said Section 5 lying southerly of Interstate 80 and Westerly of State Route 50.

Application 29102 was filed for 3.0 c.f.s. of the waters of an underground source to be diverted within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.32N., R.35E., M.D.B. & M. and to be used for the irrigation of 249 acres of land within a portion of said Section 5 and a portion of Section 33, T.33N., R.35E.

These applications were protested on April 23, 1975 by the Pershing County Water Conservation District on the grounds "that the granting of said application will affect the water table and drainage and adversely affect the decreed waters of the Humboldt River".

A hearing in the matter of these applications as well as others filed in the Imlay Segment was held on September 3, 1975 in Lovelock, Nevada. A transcript of this hearing is available in the office of the State Engineer.


