R U L I N G

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General:

Application 31025 was filed on January 25, 1977 by Keith M. Neuman and Carol F. Neuman to appropriate 1.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.M. The place of use is described as 1 acre within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T.14N., R.19E., M.D.M., and 1.5 acres within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.M.

The proposed place of use is within the boundary of the Eagle Valley Hydrologic Basin. The proposed point of diversion and 1.5 acres of the place of use is within the place of use of Permits 19044 and 20939 in the name of the Sierra Estates General Improvement District.

The proposed point of diversion is located less than 500 feet south of the Eagle Valley Ground Water Basin boundary designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030.

Approved appropriations of underground water exceed estimates of the perennial yield of the Eagle Valley Ground Water Basin.

Opinion:


It is the opinion of this office that the granting of this application for irrigation purposes within the Eagle Valley Hydrologic Basin would tend to impair the value of and adversely affect existing rights and threaten to prove detrimental to the public welfare.

Ruling:

Application 31025 is herewith denied on the grounds that the granting of additional rights to appropriate underground water for irrigation purposes within the

Eagle Valley Hydrologic Basin would impair the value of and adversely affect existing rights and threaten to prove detrimental to the public welfare.
