RULING 274

General:

On May 24, 1957 this office was advised by Mr. E. R. Greenslet, Nevada State Supervisor, Bureau of Land Management that the water sought to be appropriated was developed by Mr. Drumm, of the Silver State Construction Company, and that the cut was left open at the request of Mr. Kirk for the purpose of serving livestock in the area. It is the recommendation of Mr. Greenslet that the water sought to be appropriated remain as public water for the use of all range users within the area.

RULING

Application No. 17098 is hereby rejected for the reason that the water should remain public water and to grant a right to an individual would be contrary to public interest.
