

MR. MORROS: For the record, one more time, I'll ask if the applicants or representatives of the applicants under Applications 42118 through 42122 of the applicant, being PRO-MAX Corporation, are present in the hearing room.

MR. deLIPKAU: Yes, it does.

MR. MORROS: Initially, or first, I'm going to address Applications 42118 through 42122 filed by PRO-MAX Corporation to appropriate waters of underground storage for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes within the Truckee Canyon segment of ground water basin.

It appears that and I can only conclude that the applicants are no longer interested in pursuing these applications. It is, therefore, my ruling that to approve the applications without the additional information and data requested through the process of this hearing, in addition to a lack of expression of continuing interest on the part of the applicants in pursuing approval of these applications, that it would not be in the public interest to grant the permits under these applications; therefore, for the reasons

1 cited, Applications 42118, 42119, 42120, 42121 and 42122 are  
2 herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants have failed  
3 to indicate a continued interest in pursuing approval of the  
4 applications and have failed to provide the State Engineer  
5 with the additional information and data requested.


