

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 17108,
FILED ON NOVEMBER 29, 1956, BY THE NEVADA
SCHOOL OF INDUSTRY TO APPROPRIATE UNDER-
GROUND WATER FOR IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC
PURPOSES, IN ELKO COUNTY, NEVADA. THIS
APPLICATION WAS PROTESTED ON AUGUST 9,
1957 BY THE PERSHING COUNTY WATER CON-
SERVATION DISTRICT OF NEVADA.

RULING

General:

Application No. 17108 was filed on November 29,
1956, by the Nevada School of Industry to appropriate 2.0
c.f.s. of water from an underground source, within the
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 35 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest to the granting of said application
was filed on August 9, 1957 by the Pershing County Water
Conservation District of Nevada, on grounds that the
water table drainage and the decreed water of the Humboldt
River will be impaired.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No.
17108 is herewith overruled on grounds that the granting
of said application will not impair the value of existing
rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

On receipt of the statutory permit fee a permit
will be issued under said application subject to prior
and existing rights.
