RULING

GENERAL

Application 42581 was filed on October 3, 1980, by James L. Long to appropriate 0.23 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for commercial purposes within the N1/2 SE1/4 NW1/4 and a portion of the NW1/4 SW1/4 NE1/4, Section 15, T.3S., R.67E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE1/4 NW1/4 Section 15, T.3S., R.67E., M.D.B.&M.<sup>1</sup>

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

By letter dated September 20, 1982, the State Engineer advised the applicant that this office was prepared to act on Application 42581 and that it would be necessary for him to submit the statutory permit fee of \$100.00 or his application would be subject to cancellation. The letter was returned to this office marked "Moved, not forwardable".<sup>1</sup>

II.

On October 27, 1982, another letter requesting permit fees was sent to Mr. Long at 750 Royal Crest, Bldg. 730, Apt. 328, Las Vegas, NV 89109. This letter was returned to this office marked "Return to Sender, Not Deliverable as Addressed, Unable to Forward".<sup>1</sup>

III.

On November 22, 1982, another letter requesting permit fees was sent to Mr. Long at 750 Royal Crest Circle, Bldg. 730, Apt. 328, Las Vegas, NV 89109. This letter was returned to this office marked "Return to Sender, Not Deliverable as Addressed, Unable to Forward, Not at this Address".<sup>1</sup>

IV.

On January 25, 1984, a letter was sent by certified mail addressed to Mr. Long at his Las Vegas address requesting him to submit permit fees and advising him that failure to submit the \$100.00 within 30 days of January 25, 1984, would subject Application 42581 to denial.<sup>1</sup>

V.

As of this date, no permit fees have been received from either Mr. Long or his agent.

**CONCLUSION**

The State Engineer has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter of this action.<sup>2</sup>

**RULING**

Application 42581 is hereby denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to submit the statutory permit fees.
