RULING

GENERAL

Application 48095 was filed on June 11, 1984, by Southern Nevada Water Corporation to change the point of diversion of 1.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source heretofore appropriated under Permit 46011. The proposed use is for quasi-municipal purposes within Section 28 and Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Section 33, T.32S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the NE1/4 SW1/4 Section 28, T.32S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M.¹

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

By Order No. 861, dated June 27, 1985, the State Engineer revoked Permit 46011.¹

II.

Information available to the State Engineer's office indicates the application was filed to correct the description of the point of diversion under Permit 46011. The well under Permit 46011 was drilled at the location described under Application 48095.

CONCLUSIONS

I.

The State Engineer has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action.²

II.

Permit 46011 has been revoked, therefore there is no water right under said permit.

III.

Application 48095 was filed to change Permit 46011 which has been revoked.

RULING

Application 48095 is hereby denied on the grounds that there is no water right to change under revoked Permit 46011. Further, the well drilled at the described location of Application 48095 must be plugged and sealed within 60 days of the date of this Ruling in accordance with the regulations for drilling wells.
