RULING

GENERAL

Application 50278 was filed on October 14, 1986, by Trans-Pacific Geothermal Corporation to appropriate 3.6 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for geothermal and industrial purposes within portions of T.19N., R.31E.; T.20N., R.30E.; and T.20N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE1/4 SE1/4 Section 36, T.20N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.<sup>1</sup>

Application 50279 was filed on October 14, 1986, by Trans-Pacific Geothermal Corporation to appropriate 3.6 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for geothermal and industrial purposes within portions of T.19N., R.31E.; T.20N., R.30E.; and T.20N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE1/4 NE1/4 Section 1, T.19N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.<sup>1</sup>

Application 50280 was filed on October 14, 1986, by Trans-Pacific Geothermal Corporation to appropriate 3.6 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for geothermal and industrial purposes within portions of T.19N., R.31E.; T.20N., R.30E.; and T.20N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the NE1/4 SE1/4 Section 1, T.19N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.<sup>1</sup>

Application 50281 was filed on October 14, 1986, by Trans-Pacific Geothermal Corporation to appropriate 3.6 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for geothermal and industrial purposes within portions of T.19N., R.31E.; T.20N., R.30E.; and T.20N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the NW1/4 NW1/4 Section 7, T.19.N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M.<sup>1</sup>

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

Applications 50278, 50279, 50280 and 50281 were accompanied by Check No. 612 in the amount of \$400.00. The check was returned by Crocker National Bank marked "Cancelled".<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to NRS 533.435, a \$100.00 filing fee must accompany an application to appropriate water.

CONCLUSIONS

I.

The State Engineer has jurisdiction in this matter under the provisions of NRS 533.325 and NRS 533.435.

II.

Since the check was returned by Crocker National Bank, Applications 50278, 50279, 50280 and 50281 were not accompanied by the filing fee of \$100.00 each as required under the provisions of NRS 533.435.

RULING

Applications 50278, 50279, 50280 and 50281 are herewith cancelled on the grounds that the applicant did not submit the application fee required under the provisions of NRS 533.435.
