**RULING**

**GENERAL**

Application 51219 was filed on August 20, 1987, by Pat Cook to appropriate 0.05 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for Quasi-municipal purposes within the SW1/4 SE1/4 Section 32, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the SW1/4 SE1/4 Section 32, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M. Application 51219 became ready for action by the State Engineer's office on December 20, 1987.<sup>1</sup>

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

I.

The applicant was notified by letter from the State Engineer's office dated January 29, 1988, that Application 51219 was ready to be approved and that, in accordance with NRS 533.435, it would be necessary that the sum of \$100.00 be remitted to the Division of Water Resources. No fees were submitted as a result of that notice.<sup>1</sup>

II.

By certified letter dated June 21, 1988, the State Engineer's office notified the applicant again that the \$100.00 permit fee must be remitted within 30 days of the date of the letter or Application 51219 would be subject to denial. The certified notice sent to the Applicant was returned to this office unclaimed. A properly endorsed receipt for the certified notice was received from Applicant's agent Joseph P. Fielding. To date, no permit fees have been received for Application 51219.

CONCLUSIONS

I.

The State Engineer has jurisdiction in this matter under the provisions of NRS 533.325 and NRS 533.435.

II.

The applicant has been properly notified of the requirements for submission of the permit fees and has failed to comply with that requirement.

RULING

Application 51219 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to submit the permit fees required under the provisions of NRS 533.435.
