RULING

GENERAL

I.

Application 54991 was filed on June 25, 1990, by Vincent Development Co. to appropriate 0.36 c.f.s. from an underground source for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the NE1/4 SE1/4 Section 27, T.2N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

The State Engineer is required pursuant to NRS 533.435 to collect a fee of \$200.00 for filing each application to appropriate water of the State of Nevada.

II.

The statutory filing fee was paid by Check No. 0153 from the account of Vincent Development Company signed by Victor B. Vincent.

III.

On July 2, 1990, First Interstate Bank returned Check No. 0153 to the State Engineer with a returned item advice of debit 8343243 further remarked "insufficient funds."

CONCLUSIONS

I.

The State Engineer has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action pursuant to NRS 533.025 and NRS 533.030 subsection 1 and NRS 533.435.

II.

The filing fee of \$400.00 did not accompany Applications 54991 and 54992 since Check No. 0153 was returned unpaid by the bank.

RULING

Applications 54991 and 54992 are hereby cancelled because the applicant failed to submit the required statutory application fee.
