

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 15041, FILED MAY 12, 1953, BY MRS. P. DAMELE, TO APPROPRIATE THE WATERS OF SPRING NO. 2 FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES IN LANDER COUNTY, NEVADA. }

R U L I N G

General:

Protests to the granting of this permit were filed on June 24, 1953, by Alma Woods, on grounds that its granting would deplete the range feed, and on August 3, 1953, by Richard Magee, Inc., on grounds that the protestant claims a vested right on the waters of the spring.

On July 21, 1960, the Bureau of Land Management notified this Office that Spring No. 2 under Application No. 15041 is within the allotted range area of the applicant.

RULING

The protests to the granting of Application No. 15041 are herewith overruled on grounds that the granting thereof will not interfere with any existing water rights of the protestants. A permit will be issued under Application No. 15041 upon the receipt of the statutory permit fee.
